The NCE is currently used by 38 states (not Hawaii) for licensure/registration and grants the Massage Therapist a higher level of certification and professional stature. This review covers both versions of the exam, including the Eastern/Asian therapeutic modalities. In addition to reviewing the following subjects, we will discuss general test-taking strategies and go through a computer-based testing simulation.
